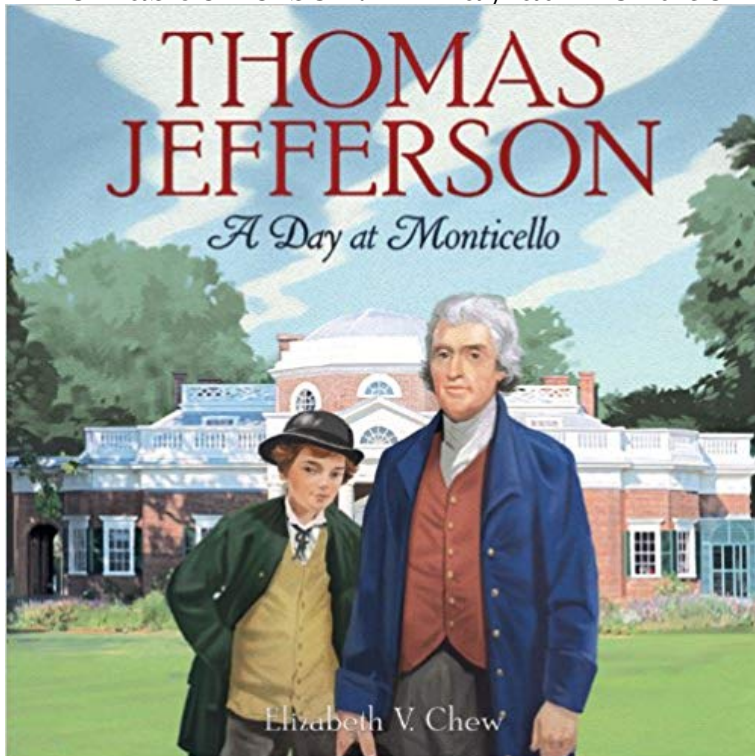


## Thomas Jefferson: A Day at Monticello
