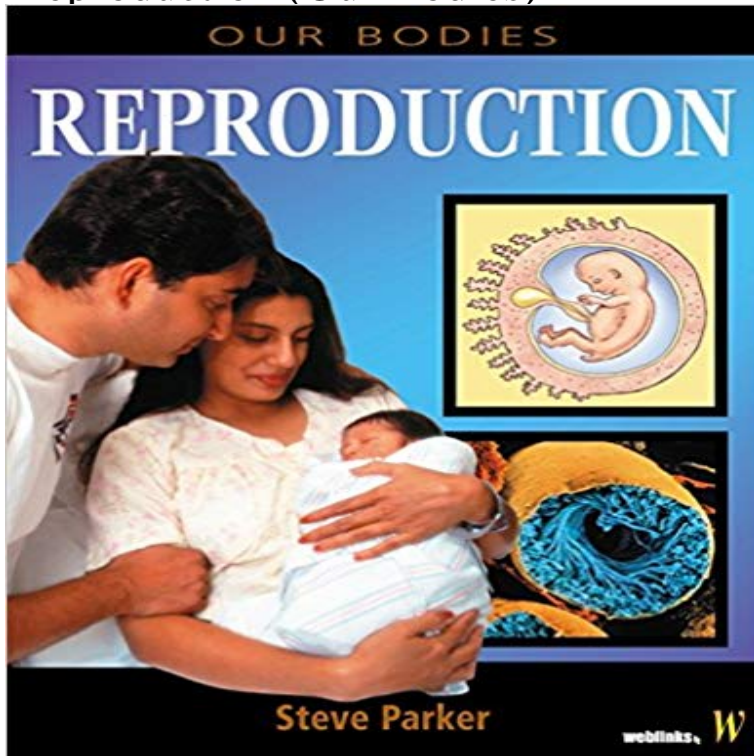


## Reproduction (Our Bodies)
